This department receives specimens from six hospitals in Mosul city (about 60% of total Mosul population).

This program divided into four years.

First year: Histopathology and Cytology.

Second year: Histopathology and Cytology & Hematology.

Third year: As in second year + IHC.

Fourth year: As in second year + Autopsy center training in the Baghdad medical city(1month duration) .

Histopathology:

The Department of histopathology at Aljamhori Teaching Hospital **receives averagely 7000 surgical specimens / year** covering a wide spectrum of neoplastic and non-neoplastic lesions including general surgical, gynecological, pediatric, obstetrics, skin, CNS, genitourinary tract specimens, and different endoscopic biopsies. This Department was the only Histopathological center in the west of Mosul city.

This work include: tissue receiving, grossing and trimming, slides reporting (elementary reporting), collecting clinical information and disease history, requested special and immune markers, extra tissue sampling, clinicopathological multidisciplinary meeting, case discussion, and final case reporting (with the responsible consultant pathologist).

Cytopathology:

The gynecological (mainly cervical smears) and the non gynecological smears including FNA of breast, thyroid, lymph node, and superficial and deep seated masses

Hematology:

The hematological cases include bone marrow aspirates and trephine bone marrow biopsies interpretation.

Frozen Sections:

During my training program few frozen sections of the breast, thyroid, CNS and GIT were performed.

Autopsy:

During my training program many post mortem autopsy dissection and examination were performed

IHC:

During my training program we received many cases that required IHC for final diagnosis.
